Safe Parking Behaviours

Please remember children are more at risk than adults around schools because they are smaller and less visible to drivers. They are also less predictable and less experienced, which makes them more likely to make errors of judgement.

Failing to follow simple [road rules](#) like parking on the verge, in no stopping zones, in bus stops, near children's crossings, on footpaths or across driveways increases the risk to children around schools. If you use the streets around the school to drop off or collect children, please be mindful of our neighbours and park safely and legally at all times.
